Training Level: Completed Proficiency Level 4.

Age (Minimum): 16 years old as of 11 July 2024.

Language: Fluent in English language (both oral and written in an academic environment); Physical fitness: Must be capable of participating in periods of moderate to vigorous physical activities (physical training (PT), team sports, etc.).

Medical limitations:

- Must be free from any medical condition that would prevent taking a part in all aspects of the CAP COS program.
- Must not have a medical limitation requiring cadet to be within 30 minutes of physician services, or that requires close supervision.

Travel requirements: Must be eligible to enter the United States and have a valid passport (valid through at least **28 January 2025**), and visa (if applicable) for travel to/from the United States.
